
Perception of Safety - 53% of respondents indicated that overall they felt mostly or completely safe. 51% of respondents considered a local area unsafe. The most frequent reason given for this perception (42%) was because they "Personally witnessed or been a victim of crime". Expanded access to community perspective beyond crime data was shown with 76% of respondents indicating they had not been a victim of a crime in the past six months


The feed provides open text comments identifying general themes and specific issues and locations. Theft, Burglaries and Break Ins was identified as the primary topic of concern countywide and was the main item of concern in 2/5 districts followed by Streets and Traffic which was the main item of concern in 2/5 districts.

Violence was the main item of concern in the East District.


