

## Procedures for 68-A Inspections

Inspections are conducted every Wednesday from 9am to 11am by APPOINTMENT ONLY. Inspections are subject to weather and personnel availability. To request an appointment please read instructions below.

### VTR 68-A Vehicle Inspections:

The Harris County Sheriff's Office Auto Theft Division **ONLY** conducts inspections for residents who reside in the unincorporated area of Harris County. If you live within the city limits contact the Houston Police Department or the agency within your jurisdiction. (ie: HPD, Fort Bend County S.O., Montgomery County S.O, Galveston County S.O., etc).

- ❖ The vehicle MUST be "ROAD READY". Inspections will not be conducted on partially assembled vehicles.

### Reasons for VTR 68-A:

- ❖ Vehicle is being imported from another country
- ❖ Vehicle is missing the VIN plate
- ❖ Assembled vehicles
- ❖ Homemade Trailers
- ❖ Any other reason the Department of Motor Vehicle has told you that you need to provide a VTR 68-A

### For all inspections you must bring:

- The vehicle
- DL/ Identification
- Insurance
- Safety Inspection
- Proof of purchase/ Bill of Sale
- Title and other documents you may have for the vehicle that may be necessary.
- Homemade Trailers must have all documentation showing how the trailer was built and where the materials came from. You must provide pictures of the trailer that show the building process from start to finish.

### Bonded Titles:

Inspections will be conducted on vehicles with Bonded Titles not currently registered in Texas.
