PERMIT TERM: An alarm system permit shall be valid for a twelve (12) month period from the date of issuance as stated on the permit, and shall expire on the last day of the twelfth month. The beginning for the renewal permit term shall be the first day of the month following expiration. Failure to receive a renewal notification does not relieve the permit holder of the responsibility of renewing the permit on time.

EXEMPTIONS:

Senior Citizen:

An alarm system on **residential** premises occupied by a permit holder who is at least sixty-five (65) years of age shall require a permit, but no permit application fee is required. False alarm response fees do not qualify under this exemption.

Government Office:

An Alarm System on premises occupied by the United States Government, the State of Texas, the County of Harris, or a publicly funded school shall require a permit, but no fee is required.

CHANGE OF INFORMATION ON PERMIT APPLICATION: The permit holder has an affirmative duty to amend any information contained or attached to the permit application that has changed or is out of date, and filed with Alarm Detail within thirty (30) days of the change in information or permit information was out of date.

OPERATING AN ALARM SYSTEM WITHOUT A PERMIT FOR RESIDENTIAL AND BUSINESS WILL BE SUBJECT TO A FEE OF \$420.00 FOR EACH UNPERMITTED FALSE ALARM.

With your **ACTIVE RESIDENTIAL ALARM PERMIT**, you get **one (1) free false alarm each permit year.**

- 2nd False Alarm = **\$100.00**
- 3rd False Alarm = **\$200.00**
- 4 or more False Alarms = **\$420.00 EACH**

For all **BUSINESSES**, regardless of permit status, the fee for each false alarm is **\$420.00.**

In addition to the fee, a citation may be issued and a fine imposed by the Justice of the Peace Court for operating an alarm system without a permit.
