# MORAL TURPITUDE

*There is no universal list of which crimes constitute crimes of "moral turpitude" and which do not. Courts have decided this on case-by-case bases.*

Moral turpitude is a legal concept in the United States and some other countries that refer to "conduct that is considered contrary to community standards of justice, honesty or good morals."

*This term appears in U.S. immigration law beginning in the 19th century.*

(Crimes involving Moral Turpitude are not limited to the below list)

1. Murder or Intentional Homicide
2. Manslaughter (depends on degree)
3. Involuntary Manslaughter
4. Kidnapping
5. Aggravated Battery

15. Aggravated Assault against a Peace Officer (*Texas Law 22.02(a)(2)(A) (Vernon 1979)*)

17. Failure to Stop and Render Aid (FSGA)
18. False Report to a Police Officer / Lying to a Police Officer (*Robertson v. State, 685 S.W.2d 488*)
19. Interfering with a Law Enforcement Officer (The Indictment indicated the use of "deadly physical force.")
